

PATERIS at the largest company run in Germany

Finish of the B2Run in Munich's Olympic Stadium

In summer 2018, the PATERIS team again participated in the fully booked, largest company run in Germany, the 6 km long B2run in Munich's Olympic Park.

Fair competition in sports and the shared experience are always key at the B2run. Dr. Ernst Fischer took the B2run slogan "We move companies - and you and your team" literally this year. After having cheered on the PATERIS running team from the edge of the track the year before, he wore running shoes himself this year and was enthusiastic: "That was the right decision - running with the team gives a completely different perspective on the group and also on one's own condition! His time was quite respectable.

The history of the B2Run began with the company run in Munich in 2004. Since the start almost 15 years ago, the number of participants in Munich has increased tenfold. More than 30,000 participants from around 1,500 companies crossed the finish line at the Olympic Stadium in 2018. This makes the B2Run Munich Germany's largest company run with individual time measurement and the birthplace of the B2Run, which now takes place in 17 German cities.

Jennifer Spannagl, paralegal trainee at PATERIS, is also pleased: "This time I trained properly and it worked out well. Of all PATERIS participants, I have improved my time the most".

Team captain Dr. Michaela Elbel: "The atmosphere was great again and the motivation in the group is really enormous. I wouldn't be surprised if we saw more PATERIS runners with times under 30 minutes next year."
